We are delighted to inform you that swimming sessions will start on the following dates:

- Years 3 and 4: 4th May, 11th May, 18th May, 25th May then 8th June
Years 5 and 6: 15th June, 22nd June, 29th June, 6th July, 13th July

The children are really looking forward to their sessions and every child will be taking part. Boys are to wear swimming trunks and not P.E. shorts please. Girls must wear a swimming costume and not a bikini.

To ensure maximum use of space and less disruption, please place both swimming costume and towel in a named plastic bag which is all that will be required to be transported to the Leisure Centre. Please ensure that your child has their swimming kit on the correct day as it is very time consuming to telephone for children who have forgotten kit.

Please note: we do not call home for Year 6 children as they will be expected to take responsibility for organizing their own kit.
