School Meals

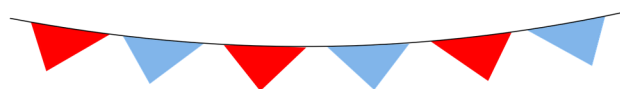


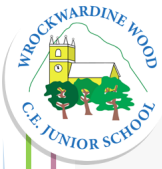
Queen's Jubilee Day Celebrations—Thursday 26th May
