Confirmation at WWJS!





On Tuesday afternoon, we welcomed a very special visitor to school. Bishop Sarah, the Bishop of Shrewsbury, came to carry out a special service of confirmation for 4 of our wonderful pupils, who have spent the past 10 weeks preparing for their confirmation with Reverend Lisa.









In recognition of the service that these pupils are giving to God as part of their confirmation, they have all been awarded their Service badge in their Christian Values passport!



If your child would like to take part in the next set of Confirmation classes, which are for year 5 and 6 pupils, please see the information below and contact the school office as soon as possible so that we can notify Revered Lisa of numbers.

As a church school, we are working to further develop our links with Holy Trinity Church. In partnership with Reverend Debbie, Reverend Lisa and their team, we intend to provide our pupils with increased opportunities to grow and develop spiritually during their time with us at Wrockwardine Wood CE Junior School.

Baptism and Confirmation for Year 5 and 6 pupils

In 2022, we hope to offer confirmation classes to pupils in years 5 and 6. Confirmation offers believers the opportunity to make a commitment to their Christian journey, marking their decision to live a responsible and committed Christian life.

Reverend Lisa, with whom the children are familiar from our weekly Open the Book worship sessions in school, would like to run confirmation classes in the spring term. These classes would prepare children to take this next step in their religious journey, leading to a confirmation service led by the Bishop in May 2022. Classes would take place in school during the children's lunch break and would last no longer than 30 minutes once a week.

In order to be confirmed in the Church of England, believers must first be baptised. However, if your child has not been baptised, this does not mean that they cannot be part of this programme, as the Bishop can perform both baptism and confirmation on the same day.

For those of you considering secondary school choices for your child: Holy Trinity Academy allocates 90 'Foundation Places' each year to '*baptised Christians, and to pupils whose families are faithful and regular worshippers*'. Further priority is given to baptised children who have attended a church school, such as Wrockwardine Wood CE Junior School. If you are interested to know more about their admissions policy, it can be found online.
