Transitions:

- **Tuesday 5th July**—Year 2 children here all day. All other children will be with their new teacher for the day. They should arrive and be registered in the their class as usual before moving up to their new teacher for the day. You will be notified in advance of the collection point for your child on the Newsletter next week.

Travel Assistance

Telford & Wrekin looks to support parents and carers to make arrangements for their children and young people, to travel safely to their allocated school or post-16 provider, and schools are asked to assist with promoting the information to enable them to do this.

If parents/carers are unable to transport their child or young person, and if they meet the [eligibility criteria](#) listed on the council's website, then travel assistance can be provided.

Please note that the deadline for applications is next week - 30 June 2022.

For assistance to be in place from September 2022, applications must be received by the council by 30 June 2022. For applications received after this date, a guarantee cannot be made that assistance will be in place for the start of the new term. If a child is over the age of 16, and parents/carers have already received transport assistance, then please ask them to re-apply by 30 June every academic year.

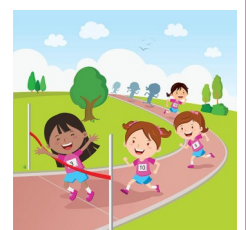


Toys and Pokemon Cards

We love running!

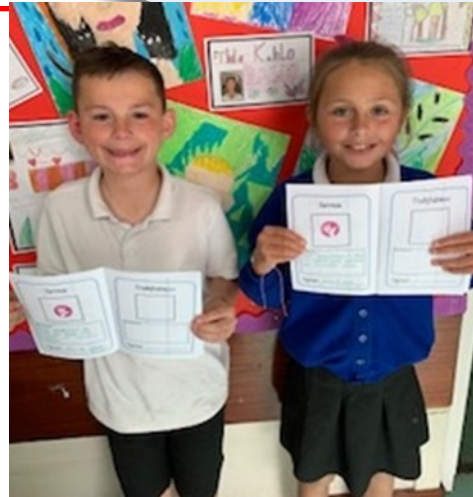
