On Monday 9th January, 5H and 5G went to Granville Country Park for a school trip, to link in with our learning of Geography this half term. We are studying our local area of Telford, which is why we visited a local nature reserve. When we arrived there, we looked around for physical and human features. Some examples of human features that we found were old mine pits, information points and mining buildings! Alongside finding these features, we tried to match some OS symbols to them and add them onto a map in our activity booklets.

After quite a walk, we found ourselves at the ruins of the mines where we became Geography Detectives and used what we could see, along with the information, to make some inferences about what these ruins could have been used for and what it told us about life in Telford in the past. To help us, we listened carefully to the teachers as they explained the history of the Granville. Eventually, we met the other group and explored around together. Penultimately, we explored an area of the Granville that contained different types of structures, so we did some quadrant work to identify how many physical and human features there were in this area.

We had so much fun we didn't want to leave but at the end we had to go back on the coach.

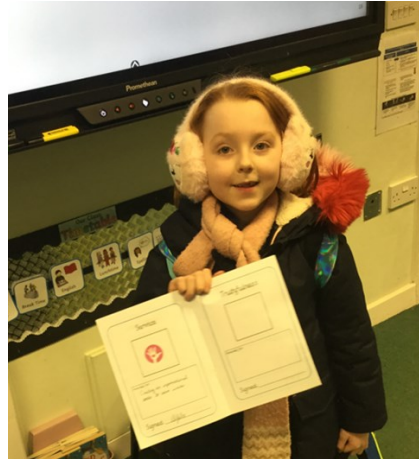
