Following the brave testimonies shared on the 'everyone's invited' website and the recent news of an inquiry being launched into sexual abuse in schools, we would like to share the details of an NSPCC helpline that has been set up to allow children, adults, parents and professionals to seek expert sensitive advice on the subject from the NSPCC and to report abuse that is historical or is currently happening in educational settings.

The number is 0800 136 663 and can be contacted Monday – Friday between 8am and 10pm, or 9am to 6pm at weekends.
