English Homework

Reading

All children take home an appropriate book from the reading scheme a free reader book (members of staff can advise children of challenging books), every week.

We ask that children read at least four times a week at home. Books create warm emotional bonds between adults and kids when they read books together. Books help kids develop basic language skills and expand their vocabulary.

Spelling

Children will bring home 10 spellings a week to learn. Children will be tested once a week to check their understanding of the rule they have been learning.
