## Attendance

Thank you to the parents who took the time to fill in our attendance questionnaire which was available at this weeks parent shadowing sessions, we are going to analyse the data and let you know the findings.

Thank you so much to everyone for your continued support in ensuring your child attends school. Every single day makes a difference!

Here in school the attendance league is hotting up once more. Well done to 3B who yet again are top of their phase with an amazing 99.26% closely followed by 3LB with 98.62%. Year 3 you really are attendance superstars! Meanwhile in upper phase, 6S have achieved a figure of 96.36% - just a touch above 6J with 96.25%

Last week our whole school attendance figure was 96.12% - slightly above the national average of 94.4%.

Follow the **SMART** rules to help stay safe online.

### Safe

# S

Stay **safe** online by not sharing your personal information.



### Meet

# M

Do not **meet** anyone who you have only become friends with online.



### Accept

# A

Do not **accept** messages and friend requests from people you do not know.



### Reliable

# R

Not everything online is **reliable**. People online are strangers and you can't always trust everything they say.



### Tell

# T

**Tell** an adult you trust if anything happens online that you do not like.



### Be careful what you share online!

Stop and think before you share information online.  
Don't say or do anything that you wouldn't do in the real world!

At Wrockwardine Wood Junior School we ensure that your children are kept safe online using a wide range of filtering and monitoring systems outlined below. Alongside this, we educate the children with a wide range of strategies to keep themselves safe on line and encourage them to report any concerns they have to a trusted adult.

## Filtering and Monitoring at Wrockwardine Wood CE Junior School

Internet filtering and monitoring is managed by our internet and network provider, Telford & Wrekin.



**smoothwall**<sup>®</sup> Access to certain sites is blocked through the T&W firewall. The firewall used in T&W is Smoothwall. The school can request access to a site if through risk assessment it is deemed safe and it has been 'overblocked' by the firewall.

### Senso

Senso is a web-based system which is set up by T&W and managed within school. This takes screen shots of any trigger words and is compiled into a weekly report which is sent to the Headteacher, Deputy Headteacher and Online Safety DSL. Staff and students' screen can be monitored through remote access to desktops. Trigger words can be set up by Telford and Wrekin but can also be amended by the school and reviewed annually to check their relevance and importance- especially if there is a series of false positive reports by a particular word. Training on the filtering and monitoring system is given through the ICT team to support the DSL and Computing Lead.



### Sophos

Sophos email is used to filter emails to protect against spam and viruses.
