## SEND Coffee Afternoon

Following on from the success of the Spring coffee afternoon, we held another one in the summer term focusing on transition. Parents and carers were able to chat to both the Infant and Secondary SEND-Cos to share information about their children and find out what support would be in place in September.



We were also visited by PODS, Family Hub (previously Strengthening

Families) and the Mental Health Team. The Mental Health Team shared their '5 Ways to Welbeing' to help support children's mental health at a difficult time of year. This information was also shared in a whole school assembly, which the children found very useful.

### PINS Project

For the academic year 2025-2026 we are lucky enough to be part of the PINS Project, which stands for Partnerships for Inclusion of Neurodiversity in Schools Project. It has been developed around the key principles of Autism in schools:

- Whole school approach
- Good quality training for staff
- Parents supporting parents group
- Understanding student's experience of school

Hopefully you have had the opportunity to complete the online questionnaire shared through Dojo to express your views. We will also be hosting a coffee afternoon on **Monday 15th September 2.15-3.15** for you to meet the team from PODS who are supporting with PINS and share your views about school to support us to improve our offer for neurodiverse children and their peers.



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## Staff Training

From September 2025 we will be utilising our fabulous Teaching Assistants differently to be able to offer a wider and more robust intervention package. As a result, they have undergone lots of training in the last few months to get ready for this, including:

- Autism Champion Training
- Direct Instruction Literacy Strategy Training
- Mental Health First Aid
  - Speech and Language interventions
