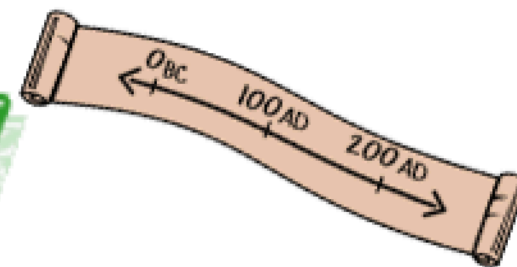




history

Ensure the Cornerstones curriculum is effectively implemented throughout the school and monitor the delivery.

Teach children about the local history through explicit links throughout a unit.

Ensure there are opportunities for cross-curricular writing.
