A 'deep dive' will take place to monitor and enable continual development of the quality of teaching and learning.



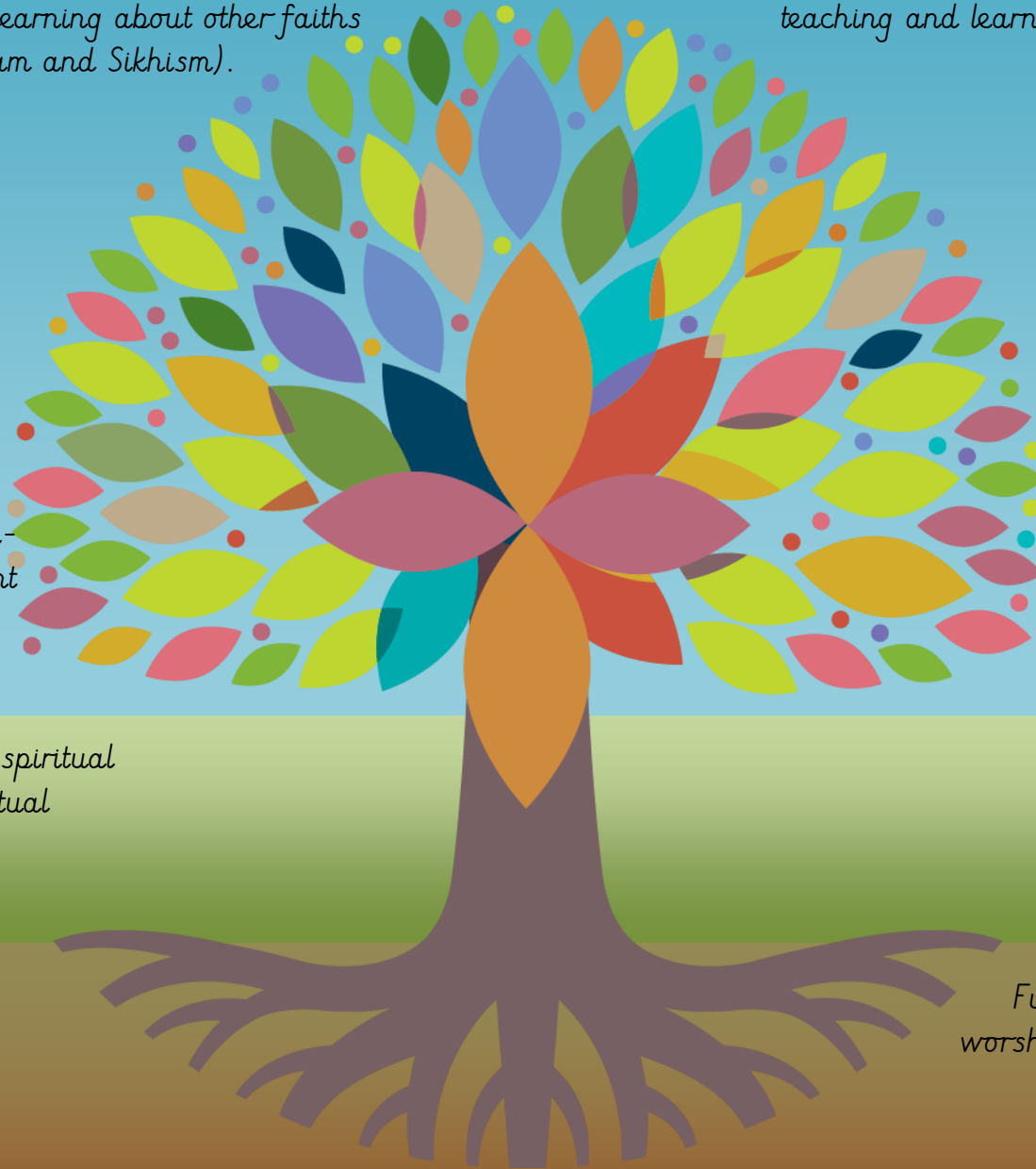
Maintain and develop reflection areas in classroom, to enable pupils to interact with the display.

Encourage pupil voice and child-led worship through development of the Spiritual Ambassadors.

Develop and monitor the use of spiritual journals to track children's spiritual development.

Nurture links with Holy Trinity Church (school involvement in (Carols by Candlelight and Y5 confirmation group).

Maintain links with Lichfield Diocese and create links with other Church of England schools in the local area.



Develop knowledge organisers to be used during units of work to support children's understanding and recall of key concepts.

Further develop assessment materials for RE, bringing it in line with other core subjects.

Create consistent cover pages for each unit of work, in line with other curriculum subjects.

Further develop daily acts of collective worship, including whole school worship, class worship and opportunities for self-reflection.

Work towards developments outlined within previous SIAMS report and termly targets set by CDA.
