Instructions

How to make perfect pancakes



You will need:

- 100g flour
- 125ml milk
- Two eggs
- A little butter
- Toppings of your choice!

Equipment:

- mixing bowl
- cup
- fork
- frying pan
- plate

What to do:

1. First, put the flour into the mixing bowl.
2. Secondly, crack the two eggs into a cup and beat them using a fork.
3. Then, slowly pour the beaten eggs and milk into the flour. Make sure you stir it well so there are no lumps.
4. Turn the hob on to a low heat.
5. Next, melt a little butter in the frying pan but be careful not to burn yourself.
6. Pour enough mixture into the pan to make a thin pancake.
7. After a few minutes, toss the pancake over to cook the other side.
8. When it is golden, serve the pancake on a plate and add your favourite topping.
9. Finally, eat your perfect pancakes.
