Hello and welcome to our first newsletter of 2024. We have had a number of children join the school since the Autumn Term, so welcome to any new parents reading this newsletter.

We now have 256 children in our school, 47 of who are on the SEND Register, making it 18% of our school. The National Average is 13%.

By the end of this term you will receive an evaluated provision map to see how hard your children and the staff working with them, have worked towards their individualised targets.

Training

All staff have received some training on 'Restorative Conversations' this term to support children after incidents. Some of our Teaching Assistants have been trained in Cool Kids, an Occupational Therapy intervention to support fine and gross motor skills.

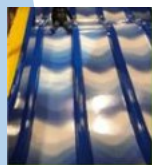

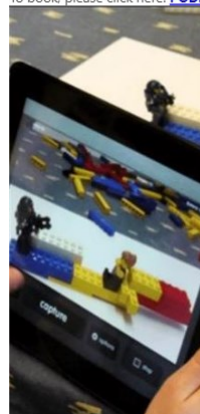
PODS Stop Motion Video Club
