## How to make perfect pancakes



#### You will need:

- 100g flour
- 125ml milk
- Two eggs
- A little butter
- Toppings of your choice!

## **Equipment:**

- mixing bowl
- cup
- fork
- frying pan
- plate

#### What to do:

- 1. First, put the flour into the mixing bowl.
- 2. Secondly, crack the two eggs into a cup and beat them using a fork.
- 3. Then, slowly pour the beaten eggs and milk into the flour. Make sure you stir it well so there are no lumps.
- 4. Turn the hob on to a low heat.
- 5. Next, melt a little butter in the frying pan but be careful not to burn yourself.
- 6. Pour enough mixture into the pan to make a thin pancake.
- 7. After a few minutes, toss the pancake over to cook the other side.
- When it is golden, serve the pancake on a plate and add your favourite topping.
- **9.** Finally, eat your perfect pancakes.


