




## **Expanded Noun Phrase**

An expanded noun phrase is a phrase made up of  $\alpha$  noun and at least one adjective. If you list more than one adjective to describe the noun, you should add a **comma** to separate them.

# lots of yummy, cold ice cream

#### Determiner

Used to introduce a noun to specify which one or how many; a/an, the, three, most.

### **Adjective**

A word that describes a noun; monstrous, vivid, delightful, familiar.

#### Noun

A person, object or animal; garage, Henry, leopard, sofa.


